## Dan Gauthier Victorious at Non-Champions

DAN GAUTHIER from New Bedford, MA became the $360^{\text {th }}$ champion in NEBA's 45 year history with a convincing 246159 championship match victory over Jonathon Corda. Dan started his weekend at Wonder Bowl with 1082 on the Saturday night squad which put him fourth on at-large list. He put together games of 226, 237, 214, 225 and 199 for 1101 on the Sunday morning seventy-two man squad for a guaranteed spot into match play by finishing ninth. In matches he continued to use his Track Rising and Mo Rich Insane Leverage to average 216.8 in matches against Tony Bennett and Craig Amaral in the best 2-of3 round, then in head-to-head's versus Steve Splain (Cheshire, CT) 204-197, Vincent Severino (West Haven, CT) 213-191, Brian Oppy (Westerly, RI) 222-195 and Jon Matunas (Newington, CT) 243-203 to advance to his first championship match since he started bowling NEBA in 2006. The 22 year-old showed no fear starting with a single pin spare then six strikes to take a sixty pin lead and cruise to a 246-159 victory over another first time finalist, Jonathon Corda. Dan won $\$ 1,600$ plus a $\$ 100$ paid entry into the Tournament of Champions and a champion's trophy and shirt; averaging 217.7 for his sixteen games in New Bedford.

JONATHON CORDA from Randolph, MA shot games of 213, 214, 258, 235 and 224 for 1144 on Sunday morning squad which placed him fourth earning him a guaranteed spot into match play. As the ninth seed he received a one round bye then defeated Jason Mele (Enfield, CT) 189-168, Ed Souza (Fall River, MA) 211-200, \#1 seed Todd Lathrop (Colchester, CT) 209195 and Jason Hebert (Templeton, MA) 215-171 en route to the championship match. Jonathon continued to use his Hammer Cherry Vibe and Brunswick Groove for spares in the final match but ended up taking home the $\$ 960$ runner-up prize after averaging 212.7 for the day. This is am impressive finish for the first cut Jonathan has made after competing in a couple tournaments per year since joining NEBA in 2004.
There were 192 entries at the non-champions tournament which advanced forty-eight bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1081. Squad cuts were 1108 on Saturday night (squad leader Bob Kuliga with 1108), 1092 at 9 a.m. (squad leader Todd Lathrop with 1220) and 1070 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader Bob Sieff with 1147). The score needed for a one round bye was 1119 ( $16^{\text {th }}$ place). The senior cut was 1108 . Bill Craig won the $\$ 50$ senior prize with 1039. Todd Lathrop was the tournament high qualifier with 1220 on the 9AM squad with games of 237, 268, 279, 229 and 207. Glenn Hood \& Steve Engel split the high game out of the money prize with 269. Ebonite balls were won by Dave Dupuis (1078) and Chris Gauvin (Raffle).
