## GILLICK BOWLS THE WORLD OVER – GETS FIRST NEBA WIN IN CRANSTON

**TIM GILLICK** from Milford, CT added his name to the list of 45 years of NEBA champions after defeating Chris Jolicoeur 234-175 at the non-champions tournament. In the few years he has competed, his previous high finish was 6<sup>th</sup> place in three tournaments. Gillick started the tournament slow with a 1027 on the Sunday morning squad (193, 187, 215, 205 and 227). He turned things around with a reentry on the last squad in which he used games of 221, 218, 247, 277 and 192 for 1155. His score was 3<sup>rd</sup> on the squad of 74 bowlers and 10<sup>th</sup> overall, which gave him a one round bye. The rightly averaged 233 in match play en route to the final match with victories over Rich Brooks (Versailles, CT) 246-199, Chris Carlson (Clinton, CT) 221-201, Donie Corneau (Riverside, RI) 222-179 and Jon Matunas (Newington, CT) 244-224. The just turned 23 year-old bowled well in the final match; tossing 6 out of 7 strikes for a 69 pin lead in the seventh frame and his first title. He won \$1,375 plus a paid entry into the 2009 Tournament of Champions, a white champion's shirt and a trophy.

**CHRIS JOLICOEUR** from Woonsocket, RI used games of 214, 224, 178, 299 and 208 on the Saturday night squad to earn a guaranteed spot in match play. His 1123 was the third highest score on the squad. The right-hander started off with 223 in the round of 3 to advance past Brandon Robertson's 238 and 195 by Joel Leider then he defeated Mike Rose (Rochester, NY) 258-192, Joey Baral (South Windsor, CT) 215- 213, John Younger (Ledyard, CT) 230-204 and Glenn Hood (Ellington, CT) 210- 157 to advance to the championship match. Jolicoeur is no stranger to high finishes at NEBA. He has over a handful of top 4 finishes and three championship match appearances. Unfortunately, this time, he shot his lowest game in match play in the final match in Cranston. He struggled to find the pocket in the front part of the match, which left him far behind Gillick. Jolicoeur averaged 222.1 for his 11 games and won \$850 for his runner-up finish.

There were 182 entries at the 2009 non-champion's weekend held at AMF Cranston Bowl. Forty bowlers advanced to match play. The at-large cut was 1096. Squad cuts were 1085 on Saturday night (squad leader **Steve Stahursky** with 1169), 1123 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **Ryan Devlin** with 1210) and 1059 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Joey Transue** with 1179). The score needed for a one round bye was 1132 (16<sup>th</sup> place). The senior cut was 1111. **Mike Bruno** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1046. **Ryan Devlin** was the tournament high qualifier with 1210 on the 9:00am squad with games of 257, 246, 279, 238 and 190. **Nick Major** won the high game out of the money prize with 279. No points were awarded since all bowlers were not allowed to compete this weekend. Ebonite balls were won by **Ron Hinkel** (1081) and **Glenn Hood** (Raffle).
