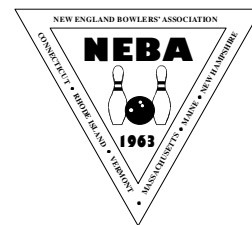
Strike in Tenth Gives Calca Fifth Title

Frankie Calca (Vernon, CT) did something seldom accomplished in the 49 year history of NEBA. He earned the #1 seed after leading the 235 bowlers in qualifying then emerged as champion. After a shaky start of 199 and 172 on the Sunday morning squad, Calca finished up with games of 225, 253 and 235 for 1084 which put him towards the bottom of the at-large list.

The 28 year old, bowled again on the next squad. He put together games of 300, 278, 234, 258 & 256 for 1326 to lead the squad and tournament. After receiving a bye, he advanced through the field to meet up with 2-time champion Chris Viale in the final match. Calca was given an early lead when Viale missed a single pin spare in the first frame. The match stayed within ten pins with each playing tossing the ball towards the gutter and filling frames. Viale finished first, which made Calca have to mark and get good count in the tenth. He threw a clean

shot to lock up his fifth win plus \$2,100 and a paid entry into the Tournament of Champions sponsored by Ebonite. Calca's first win was the first year he competed in NEBA at the 2006 Non-Champs. The next day he became the second person in sixteen years to come back Sunday and win the ToFC. The lefty's last win was in March 2010.

Chris Viale (Westfield, MA) took a similar route to the final match. He bowled both Sunday squads and qualified for match play off the last squad. After shooting 1170, the right-hander averaged 228.2 during match play. He ended up as runner-up for the day after an exciting, championship match. Viale won \$1,350 at the year's opening event. He won his first title at the Silver Lanes doubles with partner Chris Sole and his most recent was in 2009. Viale also has an impact on our organization off the lanes; serving on the board as our 2nd Vice-President.

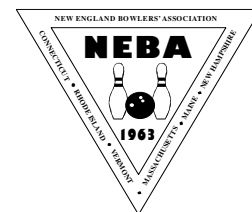
