Van Hees Completes Ten Year Mission

Jon Van Hees from Newport, RI won his second NEBA title with a clean 213-185 win over fellow champion Vic Marotto. Jon started a little slow then came on strong. The 29 year old shot games of 192, 207, 278, 268 & 249 on the Sunday morning squad. His 1195 was third on the squad which earned him a guaranteed spot in match play and a first round bye. He continued his fine bowling in match play averaging 235 as he eliminated four champions before he met Marotto in the final match. Jon bowled a clean game with X or 9/'s through the ten frames. He got up in the tenth simply needing good count for his win. Jon's prior win was when he was 19 at the 2001 non-champions event. The righty won \$1,700 plus a paid \$100 entry into the Ebonite T of C in November. For the first time, video of the final match can be seen by those not there on our Facebook page.

Vic Marotto from Wallingford, CT grabbed a guaranteed spot in match play with his 1133 on the Saturday squad (games 268, 224, 203, 232 & 206). He started striking more when the matches started averaging 255 en route to the final match. Like Van Hees, he went up against only champions in match play. The 47 year-old received \$1,000 for his runner-up finish. Marotto's previous three wins were in the '90's.

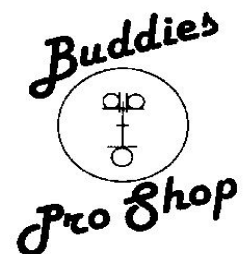
1. Tournament Summaries
2. Reports of Officers
3. Meetings – Record each meeting, keep pocket part which list the actions of the board, include pocket parts in the back of the rulebook to keep rules current, with pocket parts the rule book doesn't need to be reprinted every year
4. Running Tournament – Championship match video taped, have losers of match play bring sheets into office for faster payout
5. Trial of Stripping and Re-oiling the lanes after the last qualifying squad and before match play - Vote on whether to continue. If this new policy is implemented, discuss the impact upon the time frame. Consider starting moving the squad times earlier on Sunday. Consider putting more than one match per pair so less lanes need to be oiled. Consider one lane courtesy.
6. 2011-2012 Schedule – Add a singles tournament to February, review bid sheets
7. Added money to the Non-Champions and Tournament of Champions in November
8. Change membership from adult to all USBC members so youth bowlers can compete in NEBA.
9. Committee reports
10. New Business
