## Webb Outlasts Field at Airway Lanes for Twelfth Title

BILL WEBB from Titusville, FL is a familiar name and face to anyone who has bowled NEBA for close to the last twenty years. This is partially because he has missed only one tournament in the last 14 years and also because he is a legendary NEBA performer who has a record number of Bowler of the Year awards at seven and makes over $90 \%$ of the cuts. Even though he is the reigning Bowler of the year and his last win was in 2007 at the trios with RJ Broege and Jay Johnson, Webb hadn't won a singles title since May 2006 until he took home the win at Airway. The 38 year old started the October weekend off with 1149 on the Sunday morning squad with games of 207, 246, 222, 215 and 220. That score was sitting on the bottom part of the at-large list so he reentered. After a slow start, he earned himself a guaranteed spot off the last squad with games of 167, 234, 268, 243 and 268 for 1180. In match play, the righty averaged 251.8 including a 255 in the first round of three against Rob Corbett 246 and Jeff Voght 225 then victories over Tim Hansen (Higganum, CT) 224-171, champion Russ Michaud (Hudson, NH) 236-183, John H Bercier (Hudson, NH) 277-235 and champion Alex Aguiar (North Dartmouth) 267-215. Webb took immediate control of the championship match by throwing the first seven strikes then never looked back. He won $\$ 1,450$ plus a $\$ 100$ paid entry into the Tournament of Champions next month. This gives him 12 appearances in all 12 tournaments this year. Webb's win also moved him from fifth to second on the points list. With three tournaments to go, Webb is 48 points behind leader Alex Aguiar. It's a long shot but as long as Webb's plane gets him back in time to bowl, nobody should count him out.

MIKE CORDEIRO from Walpole, MA put games of 236, 245, 222, 237 and 238 together in Springfield for an 1178. His score was the squad cut on Sunday morning. In the first round in which two bowlers advance out of the three on the pair, he bested Tom Durand's 227 and 226 by Scott Tuccitto with a 242 to advance to round two. He cruised to the championship match as he rolled over Jeremy Hartbarger 278-250 then champions Jim Rusin (Swansea, MA) 234-201, Rob Grexer (Douglastown, NY) 188-151 and Bill Green (Westfield, MA) 228-159 for a spot in the final match. Cordeiro threw a good game but fell to Webb. He averaged 234.8 for his eleven games at Airway and took home $\$ 850$ for his runner-up finish. The 43 year old won his first title in March 2008 at AMF Circle Lanes.
There were 183 entries in NEBA's first regular singles tournament at AMF Airway Lanes. The center was limited to special tournaments like the Point Leaders' Invitational until they converted some of their candle pin lanes into ten pin so they had the 40 lanes needed to host NEBA. The at-large cut for the forty bowlers who advanced to match play was 1144 . Squad cuts were 1200 on Saturday night (squad leader Alex Aguiar with 1300), 1178 at 9 a.m. (squad leader Mike Bissmann with 1245) and 1146 at $12: 30 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. (squad leader Rob Grexer with 1232). The score needed for a one round bye was 1187 ( $16^{\text {th }}$ place). Three seniors made the squad or at-large cuts out of the 21 senior entries so there was no separate senior cut ( $3^{\text {rd }}$ senior was 1149). Ted Kone won the extra $\$ 50$ senior prize with 1120. Current point leader Alex Aguiar posted a 1300 (games of 218, 289, 238, 276 , 279) on the Saturday night squad which held up as the tournament high qualifier so he earned him $\$ 75$ and five points. Steve Fiume won the high game out of the money prize with 257. Ebonite Evolves and Booms were won by Brian Boghosian (1144) and Jim Harger (reservation raffle). The field averaged 214.4 in qualifying and 222.8 in match play.
