### GOOF FOOLS 'EM AT AMF CHICOPEE FOR FIRST TITLE

CHRIS GAUVIN from South Grafton, MA earned his first NEBA title with a 267-236 win over champion Chris Hall in the final match at Chicopee Lanes. This adds to the best year Gauvin has had since he started competing in NEBA in 2001. This season he is one of only three bowlers who have made the cut in all seven tournaments and is currently fourth on the point list. In Chicopee, Goof shot 1122 with games of 232, 223, 235, 211 and 221 on the 9AM squad. His score was towards the bottom of the at-large list so he reentered. Even though his first score was enough to make the cut, he made a wise choice to reenter as he put together games of 259, 203, 246, 258 and 267 for 1233 to led the squad and grab the #2 seed in match play. Gauvin started off slow in matches against Geoff Wetzler (Coventry, CT) 199-198 and new member Bryan Easterbrooks (Lyndonville, VT) 189-165 then came on strong with victories over champions Dave Reali (Cranston, RI) 234-213 and Rich Valenti (East Haven, CT) 265-169. Goof made impressive shots in his second career championship match; starting the match with the front five, going a little high in the sixth for a 4-7, then adding a triple to finish the match first and guarantee him the title. The 31 year old righty won \$1,500 and a \$100 entry into the Tournament of Champions plus a championship trophy and white shirt. Gauvin averaged 241.3 for his fifteen games. His other championship match appearance was at the doubles in 2002 with partner Bruce Hall.

CHRIS HALL from Waterford, CT doesn't mind coming to Chicopee. His first title was there in June 2004 and nearly his second. This year, Hall started his day at the AMF center with games of 232, 230, 256, 215 and 262 for 1195 and a guaranteed spot off the last qualifying squad. In matches, the 28 year old lefty averaged 216.4 as he defeated champion Ollie Ellard (Chicopee, MA) 184-152, current point leader William Tessier (Woonsocket, RI) 214-189, champion Barry Warshafsky (Peabody, MA) 235-189 and 6-time Bowler of the Year Bill Webb (Enfield) 213-208. Hall bowled great in the championship match, leaving only five pins standing (four 7-pins & one 8-pin), but Gauvin stayed ahead with a couple extra strikes. He won \$900 for his runner-up finish and moved up to fifth in points.

There were 145 entries at AMF Chicopee Lanes which advanced forty-eight bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1110. Squad cuts were 1146 on Saturday night (squad leader **Chris Monroy** with 1211), 1171 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **RJ Broege** with 1266) and 1133 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Chris Gauvin** with 1233). There were no byes. The senior cut was 1091. **John Campo** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1078. **RJ Broege** was the tournament high qualifier with 1266 on the 9:00 squad with games of 237, 268, 248, 234, and 279. **Steve Engel** & **Neil Binder** shared the \$50 high game out of the money prize with games of 279. Ebonite balls were won by **Bob Miles** (Raffle) and **Todd Lathrop** (1107). The field averaged 205 in qualifying and 213 for matches. **Honor Scores**: **300- Chad Autore**

\* There are alternative routes so it is best to check a map or on-line directions from your address \*

From Hartford, CT: Follow I-84/US-6 to exit 55 (Route 2 East for 36 miles) to exit 28N (I-395 North/Governor John Davis Lodge Turnpike for 21 miles). Keep right to take Governor John Davis Lodge Turnpike via exit 90 which becomes Route 6 East. Stay on route 6 East for about 20 miles. Merge onto Route 10 South. \*\*\* Take the Union Avenue exit toward Huntington Avenue then slight right onto Cranston Street. Take quick left onto Niantic Avenue. Center is in 0.4 miles.

<u>From Boston, MA, ME & NH</u>: Take best route to I-95 South into RI. \* Take exit 22B (Route 10 South/Huntington Expy.) After 1.7 miles, follow \*\*\* above

From Springfield & Worcester, MA & VT: Take best route towards Providence, RI to I-95 South (I-91, I-90E/Mass Pike, Route 146) and follow \*above.
