# **CALCA GETS EVEN AT LAUREL SHOOT OUT**

**FRANKIE CALCA** from Elmont, NY won his third NEBA championship in a rematch against red hot Alex Aguiar. Only two tournaments ago, at East Providence Lanes, Calca fell victim to Aguiar's sixth NEBA win by only two pins, 224-222. This time, however, it was Calca who was victorious by a larger margin, 267-234. Calca filled all the frames in the final match, while Aguiar suffered a 4-9 open early in the match. Although the Aguiar struck in all but one of the remainder of the frames, Calca led the match from start to finish. The young lefty struck on his first ball in the tenth to shut Aguiar out on the bench. After not making the cut Saturday night with 1157, and his Sunday morning squad score of 1022, Calca bowled a third time. The 25 year old scored 1154 which made the squad cut and gave him the number 36 seed of the 40 in match play. The first two rounds seemed to be a breeze for Calca. In round one he teamed up with Chris Rebstock to eliminate John Rusin (228 by Calca, 267 Rebstock, 196 by Rusin) then beating Steve Jones 233-172. Round three was a close one with Calca knocking out Joe Azukas by only two pins, 224-222. Rounds four and five were won again with larger margins, beating Chris Wujek 233-200 and Scott Santos 247-194. Calca adds his win at AMF Laurel Lanes to his two from 2006. In his first year of competing in NEBA, he won the Non-Champions and Tournament of Champions which made him the second person to win both in the same weekend. This year, after not bowling the month of January, Calca has made it to match play in all three tournaments he bowled including two championship match appearances. As it stands, he is second to Alex Aguiar in points for Bowler of the Year, making them the bowlers to beat so far.

**ALEX AGUIAR** from North Dartmouth made it to match play off the at-large list at Laurel Lanes after shooting 1214 (245, 268, 222, 247, 232) on Saturday night. Aguiar worked his way through match play by eliminating out Brian Egan in the first round of three (188 Aguiar, 193 Matunas, 170 Egan) then Ron Canalia 236-200, champion Jon Van Hees in round three 254-162, Mike Repsch 211-180 and Dave Kipperman 233-211 taking him to the final round against Calca. Aguiar bowled well in the final match, striking on eight of eleven attempts, but it wasn't enough to keep up with Calca. This final match appearance was Aguiar's second out of the four regular singles tournaments this year. He has competed in all the tournaments in 2009 making it to match play in all five. He took home the Point Leaders' Invitational crown in January and won in East Providence the next month. Aguiar currently holds the top spot on the point leaders list.

There were 189 entries at Laurel Lanes which advanced forty bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1186. Squad cuts were 1239 on Saturday night (squad leader **Keith DeMaine** with 1265), 1192 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **RJ Broege** with 1286) and 1143 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Jon Van Hees** with 1243). The score needed for a one round bye was 1221 (16<sup>th</sup> place). The senior cut was 1164. **Dave Forcier** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1140. **RJ Broege** was the tournament high qualifier with 1286 on the 9 a.m. squad with games of 280, 290, 225, 258 and 233. **Jayme Silva** won the high game out of the money prize with 300. An Ebonite Striking Motion was won by **Ali Dihmes** (1184) and Pin Slasher by **Ryan Devlin** (raffle).

The field averaged 214.5 in qualifying and 223.1 during match play.

#### MINUTES FROM THE BOARD MEETING HELD APRIL 19, 2009 IN PLAINVILLE, CT

Board Members Present: President Chris Monroy, 1<sup>st</sup> VP Alex Aguiar, Sec/Treas Becky Kregling, TD Jack Stehle, John Ellis, Dave Forcier, Tim Healey, Mike Lichstein, Ed Roberts & Past President Dave Cannata. Board Member(s) Absent: 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Rob Hunter, Larry King & Chris Rebstock. Member(s) Present: Brian Boghosian

- 1. Reports of Officers and Tournaments Reports accepted
- Sponsors Motion by Jack Stehle to accept Ebonite's sponsorship offer for 2009-2010 which includes 40 balls and \$2,000. Second by Alex Aguiar. Passed.
- 3. Rule Clarification An incorrect ruling was made a few months back. Per USBC rules, it is allowed to switch hands during competition in a non-classified scratch tournament.
- 4. Rule Change Motion by Ed Roberts to allow bowlers to enter unlimited brackets. This removes the restriction upon reentries which already made a squad cut. Second by Tim Healey. Passed 5-3.
- 5. Side Pots Motion by Ed Roberts to eliminate the Xor9 Jackpot and put the \$2 that was allocated to the Xor9 into the high game pots plus change the 8-Strike to an 11-Strike jackpot still held in game 5. Second by Dave Cannata. Passed.
- 6. Rule Change Motion by John Ellis to eliminate open paid practice once lanes have been conditioned for tournament. Second Ed Roberts. Passed 5-4.
- 7. Committees The president will appoint committees
- 8. Tournament Director Position The five people who submitted resumes for the tournament director position will be interviewed by the board on the afternoon of Saturday, May 16 at Westgate Lanes. The board will establish a list of questions for each candidate. To win a vote, a candidate must receive 50% of the secret ballot.
- 9. New Business A proposal was made to guarantee larger first and second place prize money, eliminate the squad and senior cuts by using 1 in 5 squad cuts and raise the entry fee. That proposal will be reworked and presented at the next meeting. A proposal was made to reevaluate the salary structure and clarify the duties of the tournament director and secretary/treasurer since the positions are changing after eleven years of employees working together and new responsibilities exist. That will be done via email before the interviews.
