AGUIAR STAYS HOT IN THE WINTER – WINS EP FOR 2ND TITLE OF '09

ALEX AGUIAR from North Dartmouth, MA grabbed another win after narrowly defeating fellow champion Frankie Calca 224-222 at East Providence Lanes. This makes it two titles in the first two months of this year. At EP, the 29 year old earned a guaranteed spot into match play with games of 236, 254, 247, 234 and 258 on the Saturday night squad. His 1229 was 7th out of the 285 entries and worth a one round bye. In match play, Aguiar averaged 238 in route to the championship match as he scored victories over Clayton Swartz (Merrimack, NH) 228-169, James Jordan (Lowell, MA) 227-225, Glenn Hood (Ellington, CT) 254-213, Brandon Robertson (Clinton, CT) 246-192 and champion Butch Paternostro (Wethersfield, CT) 237-180. In the final match, Aguiar started with a double to immediately take the lead but left a 6-7-10 split in frame three to give the lead to his opponent. The strapping righty trailed through the end of the match but struck out from the ninth to make Calca throw 9/ for the win. A high hit by the young lefty, gave Aguiar his sixth career title. He won \$2,100 plus another champion's shirt and trophy.

FRANKIE CALCA from Elmont, NY shot 1095 on Saturday night then put together games of 246, 223, 225, 275 and 216 on the Sunday morning squad for 1185 and a guaranteed spot into match play. He continued his striking as he defeated champion Chad Autore (Naugatuck, CT) 245-215, Randy Hagemoser (North Kingston, RI) 278-244, champion RJ Broege (West Hartford, CT) 237-206, John Williston (Worcester, MA) 184-180 and champion Jon Van Hees (Newport, RI) 242-215 for a spot in the final match. Calca missed the pocket on two shots in the championship match. Unfortunately, one was in the tenth when all he needed was nine to take home his third win. He left a 6-10 which handed the title to Aguiar. The 25 year old won \$1,200 for his runner-up finish.

There were 285 entries at East Providence. The at-large cut for 56th place was 1148. The score needed to receive a one round bye (8th place) was 1151. The senior cut was 1148 (25 senior entries gave 4 guaranteed spots – 4 seniors made the at-large or squad cuts). Squad cuts were 1142 on Saturday 6 p.m. (squad leader **Dan Gauthier** with 1230), 1180 on Sunday 9 a.m. (squad leader **Chris Monroy** with 1300) and 1156 on Sunday afternoon (squad leader **Chris Wood** with 1213). High Qualifier was **Chris Monroy** with 1300 (258-268-278-249-247) on the 9:00 squad. **Michael Nai & George Tignor** split the \$50 high game out of money prize with 300 games. **Mike Slipski** won the \$50 prize for the highest senior who did not make the cut with 1140. The winners of Ebonite balls were Scott Cole (raffle for Pin Slasher) and **John Ellis** (score of 1147 for NVS).
