



JUST PLAYING THE GAME, VIALE GETS LONG AWAITED SECOND TITLE

CHRIS VIALE from Westfield, MA finally added a NEBA singles title to his long resume of bowling accomplishments after defeating Alex Aguiar 195-179 in the championship match at AMF Silver Lanes. He adds this to his doubles title which was also won at Silver Lanes in 2002 with partner Chris Sole. Viale has achieved many awards since college and found success at tournaments all over, his more recent was representing the USA and American region at the World Ranking Masters earlier this year in Italy, but a NEBA singles title eluded him until now. The 41 year-old suffered a rough start at Silver shooting 824 on Saturday night. He didn't let that deter him. He came back and led the last qualifying squad on Sunday with 257, 245, 161, 223 and 213 for 1099. After receiving a one round bye, the righty eliminated Tim Gillick (Milford, CT) 192-162, Danny Gauthier (New Bedford, MA) 210-150, RJ Broege (West Hartford, CT) 248-235 and Stephen Dale Jr. (Newton, NH) 218-194. He opened his thumb en route to the final match but gutted it out and made great shots in the championship match. He started with five flush pockets shots which resulted in four of five strikes and a 27 pin lead over Aguiar. Viale finished the match out; keeping his lead. He won \$1,500 plus a \$100 entry into the Tournament of Champions, a new white champion's shirt and trophy.

ALEX AGUIAR from North Dartmouth, MA started his weekend at Silver with a 166 on Saturday night then it was all uphill. He finished the squad with 243, 211, 195 and 204 for 1019. As the fourth highest score on the squad of 46 bowlers, he earned a guaranteed spot in match play. After helping in the office during the last qualifying squad, he went out on the lanes and defeated Gary Kurensky (Bridgeport, CT) 221-167 and Cliff Wheelock (Florence, MA) 234-201 then a couple tenth frame nail biters against Jim Rusin (Swansea, MA) 222-217 and Donie Corneau (Riverside, RI) 212-209 before meeting up with Viale in the championship match. Luck wasn't with Aguiar at the beginning of the final match as he left a variety of single pins. He was never able to put pressure on the determined Viale. Aguiar ended with his second runner-up finish of the year and \$850. His performance at Silver moved him back into the lead for Bowler of the Year. The 29 year-old righty has made seven cuts out of the eight regular tournaments he had bowled with four semi-final appearances out of those eight. He also won the Ebonite Point Leader Invitational in January. This is Aguiar's best year in NEBA since winning his first title at the non-champions in 1999.

There were 201 entries at AMF Silver Lanes which was the first time we hit 200 for the summer. Forty-eight bowlers advanced to match play. The at-large cut was 976. Squad cuts were 986 on Saturday night (squad leader **Chris Sole** with 1109), 987 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **Bill Webb** with 1109) and 1014 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Chris Viale** with 1099). The score needed for a one round bye was 1034 (16th place). Seven seniors made the squad or at-large cuts out of the 32 senior entries so there was no separate senior cut. **Fran Verni** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 961. **Chris Sole** was the tournament high qualifier with 1109 on the 6PM squad with games of 207, 214, 224, 254 and 210. **Chris Sole** was the only person who was able to put together five 200 games in a qualifying block on the demanding low scoring conditions. **Billy Trudell** won the high game out of the money prize with 257. Ebonite Magic Touches and Booms were won by **Sal Santinello** (raffle) and **Ryan Devlin** (974 with high game of 228). The field averaged 183.8 in qualifying and 200.1 in match play.

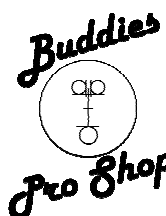

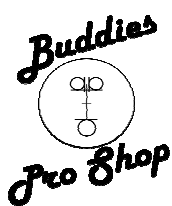
