Aguiar Hammers the Field at Wonder Bowl

Alex Aguilar from North Dartmouth, MA won his 7th title with a 237-216 final match victory over RJ Broege. After shooting 1151 on Saturday night, Aguilar didn't take his chances to make it off the at-large list & re-entered the last squad Sunday after attending the morning board meeting. He shot games of 228, 215, 242, 259 & 230 for 1174 and a guaranteed spot in match play. Aguilar's route to the championship match included a couple close wins. Broege took the early lead in the final match with a double then each bowler's pockets hits resulted in X or 9/. Aguilar's triple in the sixth gave him the lead and another in the tenth forced Broege to strike out to tie. A smash 10 gave Aguilar, the 2009 Bowler the Year, his 7th title & first win since last February. The righty won \$1,650 plus a paid \$100 entry into the Ebonite T of C in November.

RJ Broege's second place finish may be lower than what he hoped for but this finish along with his two other top 8 finishes moved him to the top of the point list after four tournaments. Like Aguilar, Broege used a second entry on the last qualifying squad to qualify for match play after falling short on Saturday night. The lefty averaged 237.1 in match play & won \$950.

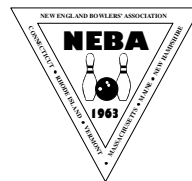

Bowlers who are not checked in 15 minutes prior to the squad's scheduled start may be shut out or not allowed to check in until after the squad is started. This is being enforced to ensure our squads start on time even if bowlers choose to arrive late.

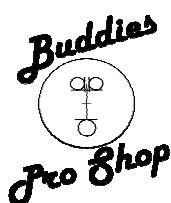
Minutes from the Meeting held on April 18th at Wonder Bowl, New Bedford, MA

Board Members Present: President Chris Monroy, 1st VP Alex Aguiar, Sec/Treas Becky Kregling, TD Joey Nereu, Matt Brockett, Mike Bissmann, John Ellis, Dave Forcier, Rob Grexer, Tim Healey, Larry King, Dave Kipperman, John Younger, Chris Viale.

Member(s) Present: Billy Trudell

Board Member(s) Absent: 2nd VP Rob Hunter, Ed Roberts, John Bercier, Chris Forry, Rich Macierowski, Russ Michaud, Jack Stehle, Jon Van Hees

1. Tournament summaries were given by Joey Nereu.
2. Reports of Officers were given by President Monroy and Sec/Treas Becky Kregling
3. Sponsors – Motion by John Younger to renew the contract with Ebonite under the same terms as the current contract for 2010-11. Second Mike Bissman. Passed unanimously.
4. Senior & Women's Cuts – There were discussion about eliminating the senior cut and adding a women's cut. There was not enough interest in changing either rule for a motion to vote.
5. Create a cut off time for check-in – There was lengthy discussion about how to address the issue of bowlers showing up late to check-in and pay. This has become an issue since paid practice was eliminated in 2009. It was a major problem during the start of the year when entries are the highest since it was impossible to check in all the bowlers in line without starting the squads late. Instead of making a rule with a specific time to shut off entries, it was reiterated that the tournament director reserves the right to stop taking entries. Per the NEBA rulebook, "All participants are required to report to the Tournament Director at least thirty (30) minutes prior to their squad time... Failure to do so shall subject the member to a fine of not more than \$10." And "The Tournament Director reserves the right to reassign reservations for any bowler who does not report and pay the entry fee at least fifteen (15) minutes prior to their scheduled qualifying squad time." Those rules will be publicized along with a warning that bowlers may get shut out. In the future, entries will be accepted until the tournament director needs to start the squad. The squad will be started on time. If there are more people in line, entries will be taken after the announcements and the start of practice. The board felt starting the squads on time was very important.
6. Lane conditions – Motion by Becky Kregling to Instruct the TD to take a more active role in working with the bowling centers on what lane condition will be put out for the tournament. Second by John Ellis. Passed 6-1. A committee will help define that active role.
7. Lane conditions – There was no motion for NEBA to notify the bowlers what lane condition will be used at the upcoming event in advance.
8. Redress Lanes during the tournament – There was no motion to Strip and Re-oil the lanes before the 1230pm squad when the centers' league schedule permits. There was a motion by Matt Brockett to oil the lanes before match play on a trail basis with the trail being held through the tournament in which the next meeting tournament is held based upon the centers ability and agreement since it this new rule isn't in our contract with the centers. Second by Mike Bissmann. Passed unanimously. We will keep records of how much time is added during the trial. The May-September centers will be contacted by Joey or Becky ASAP to see if they will oil 34 lanes before match play.
9. Special May Tournament – Details were confirmed the May special format tournament. Postcards will be sent to all members and people who bowled in the last two years.
10. Invitational Tournament to be held in January 2011
 - Motion by Larry King to name the tournament based upon points the Cambridge Credit Counseling Invitational and the Tournament of Champions the Ebonite Tournament of Champions. Second by Mike Bissmann. Passed unanimously
 - Motion by Larry King to change to format of the Cambridge Credit Invitational. Second by Rob Grexer. Passed 8-1.
 - ... Field limited to 48 bowlers based upon points
 - ... Entry fee \$150
 - ... Half the field cashes with the last spot being \$150
 - ... Qualifying - 5 games then cut to the top 24 ... Semi-finals - 3 games then cut to the top 16 ... Finals - 4 bowlers per pair with matches between those on each pair. 5 matches plus 1 position round. Ten bonus pins will be awarded each person beat on the pair (30 for 1st, 20 for 2nd, 10 for 3rd, 0 for 4th on the pair).
11. Out of Money Awards – Motion by Mike Bissmann to limit the number of out of money awards to one per person per tournament. Award order is the ball from the sponsor, high senior out of the money and high game out of the money
12. Prize Fund Payout – There will no longer be a difference in prize money each round so each round pays out the same amount.
13. Committees will be formed during the summer with the President making committee appointments
14. New Business – Motion by Alex Aguiar to compensate the six bowlers who were told they made the cut and given lane assignments for their match before an error in the cut was found at the January tournament at Silver Lanes by offering them an \$80 paid entry into a 2010 tournament. Second by Matt Brockett. Passed unanimously.
15. New Business – Motion by Alex Aguiar to remove Rob Hunter from the office of 2nd Vice President for missing 4 consecutive meetings. Second Dave Forcier. Passed. The board appointed Tim Healey to take over the 2nd Vice President position by a motion by Alex Aguiar, second by Dave Kipperman and unanimous vote of the board of directors.
16. Meeting adjourned at 11:18AM. Next scheduled meeting September 12 at Nutmeg Bowl in Fairfield, CT
